She is a member of a percussion collective, Abstruckt. Also a co-founder of Hidden Keileon, an artist collective collaborating with migrant and queer people to imagine futures with freedom and justice for all by dreaming and leading multidisciplinary and life-affirming projects

Lucia H Chung is a Taiwanese artist based in London, United Kingdom. She performs and releases music under the alias 'en creux' where the sound creation springs from her fascinations in noise generated through no-input feedback mixing board. The volatile nature of the system and the unpredictable glitch from the excessive energy pouring into the equipment becomes her improvisational and compositional strategy.

M.E.L.T is a dynamic improvisation group that invites listeners on a journey through ambient music, field recordings and noise/drone soundscapes. The group's name, an acronym for Making, Electronicmusic, Live, Together, reflects its commitment to exploring the technical, social, and political dimensions of sonic artistry through improvisation.

TUTOR PROFILE: FENELLA BARKER

Fenella Juanita Barker

Performer, Teacher, Choreographer - Flamenco, Spanish Dance, Ballet & Other Dance Styles

Fenella Juanita Barker (also known as Ella Barker and Fenella Rathbone) attended her first ballet class at age four and had her television debut as a professional dancer in 1977 on BBC1's Billy Smart's Children's Circus.

Fenella has been teaching dance at Morley College London for 27 years. She currently teaches Flamenco, Spanish Dance and Ballet (including Silver Swans). For over ten years, she has also been joint Project Manager of the annual Flamenco & Latin Cabaret at Morley.



Fenella has worked full time as a professional

dancer, teacher and choreographer since 1990, touring to USA, Canada and throughout UK and Europe, working in theatre, opera, cabaret, cruises, TV, video and film. In London she has performed in numerous venues including the Royal Opera House, Barbican, ICA, Wembley, Earl's Court and Olympia. Dance companies include: National Character Dance Company, Romanska Folk Ballet, Springs Dance Company, MAS Dance, Cooperative Dance Theatre, Flamenco y Danza, Grupo Flamenco de Londres & Bayan Cossacks.

Fenella is currently performing with Grupo Flamenco de Londres, Flamenco y Danza and also as a freelance solo artist, with recent work including a performing residency in London along with theatre performances as far away as Spain and Malta.





TUTOR PROFILE: FLAVIO VIGNI

Jazz Drummer, Composer & Educator

Flavio Li Vigni, hailing from Palermo, Sicily, Italy, is a London-based jazz drummer, composer, and educator. He earned his degree in Jazz Performance from The Prince Claus Conservatory under the mentorship of American jazz drummer Ralph Peterson, and later pursued a Masters Degree in Jazz at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama, supported by a Leverhulme Trust Scholarship.

Beyond his role in

academia, Flavio maintains an active international performance schedule. He has collaborated with artists such as Greg Hutchinson, Ameen Saleem, and the "Orchestra Macchina di Suoni" featuring Dave Kikoski. A fixture in the London jazz circuit, Flavio has played at venues including the Royal Albert Hall, The




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Queen Elizabeth Hall, Ronnie Scott's, Pizza Express, and the Vortex. His performances have also been showcased at festivals spanning the UK, Italy, The Netherlands, Spain, China, Poland, Germany, Lithuania, Croatia and Albania.

Flavio's dedication to sharing his knowledge extends globally, as evidenced by his workshops conducted across Europe and China. As a tutor on the Guildhall School of Music and Drama jazz summer school, he mentors and fosters emerging talent. Additionally, Flavio collaborates regularly with the educational team at Jazz at Lincoln Centre, founded by Wynton Marsalis.
